

Conditions for joining the Association

Any commercial and non-commercial organizations whose activities do not contradict the purpose and subject of the Association's activities can become members of the Association, and the following is carried out:

- in the energy and oil and gas complex, including oil and gas construction, processing, chemistry, service, pipeline transport, gas facilities operation, transportation and sale of liquefied gas, sale of petroleum products, geological exploration of hydrocarbon deposits, research and development work (R& D) and other areas of activity;
- in the field of ecology, nature management, renewable and alternative energy sources;
- in the field of higher and (or) postgraduate education and scientific organizations.

Admission to the Association is carried out by decision of the General Meeting of the Association members on the basis of a written application of a legal entity addressed to the Chairman of the Association and payment of an entrance fee (clause 14 of the Charter of the Association).

The list of documents required when joining the Association:

- 1) a written application of a legal entity addressed to the Chairman of the Association (in any form);
- 2) a document confirming the payment of the entry fee;
- 3) a copy of the charter of the legal entity;
- 4) a brief description of the activities of a legal entity wishing to join the Association (preferably in Russian and English);
- 5) the decision of the competent body of the legal entity to join the Association (original or extract from the decision);
- 6) a copy of the certificate of state registration (re-registration) of the legal entity.

On the basis of the application received, the issue of admission of a candidate to the membership of the Association is submitted for consideration by the General Meeting of Members of the Association (clause 14 of the Charter of the Association), which makes an appropriate decision.
